ACTION REQUESTED

It is respectfully requested that your Board adopt a resolution authorizing the Chief Probation Officer to sign and approve a Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant award agreement (JAB2006) authorizing the Chief Probation Officer to enter the County into any necessary contractual obligations to execute said award agreement. The Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant became available several years ago through the California Corrections Standards Authority (formerly the Board of Corrections) providing funding (\$11,881) for programs as funded under this grant.

BACKGROUND

The Juvenile Accountability Incentive Block Grant (JAB2006) became available several years ago through the California Corrections Standards Authority (formerly the Board of Corrections) providing funding (\$11,881) for programs as funded under this grant. The City of Roseville Police Department and the Chief Probation Officer have jointly agreed to continue to undertake citation hearings and parenting programs utilizing these funds. This will allow the Probation Department to enhance our operations in the Children's System of Care through the development of other resources in the communities we serve.
