ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$500 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Loomis Basin Chamber of Commerce for the new Chamber Office as requested by Supervisor Holmes (\$250) and Supervisor Gaines (\$250).

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Loomis Basin Chamber of Commerce is in the process of constructing a new Chamber office. The new office will be located at the intersection of Horseshoe Bar Road and Doc Barnes Avenue in Loomis. The Town of Loomis is offering a 30-year lease on the land and the modular unit is being donated. The funds designated to this program will help with the costs of permits, utility connections, grading, paving, foundation work, landscaping and signage.
