SUBJECT: Contract with Kings Beach Family Resource Center for participation in the Healthy Families Rural Health Demonstration Project

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve the agreement with North Lake Tahoe La Comunidad Unida, dba Kings Beach Family Resource Center (KBFR) for participation in the Healthy Families Rural Health Demonstration Project administered by Delta Dental from July 1, 2006 through June 30, 2007 for the amount not to exceed \$45,000, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the agreement and subsequent amendments.

BACKGROUND:

In February 2006, the KBFR commenced participation in the Healthy Families Rural Health Demonstration Project Grant known as the Tahoe Truckee Oral Health Project, providing services through both the Truckee and Kings Beach Family Resource Center.

This project provides dental health education to parents of children ages 6 and older in both English and Spanish. The KBFR assists in management for treatment of those children with serious dental needs, encourages parents to follow through with accessing treatment and keeping dental appointments, and coordinates transportation needs to the County Dental Clinic in Kings Beach. KBFR also assists the County Dentist and Dental Assistant in performing annual school-based dental screenings at Kings Beach Elementary School and other Tahoe/Truckee schools as requested by County for children ages 6 through 18 in English and Spanish.

This program is funded through the Delta Dental Healthy Families Rural Health Demonstration Project Grant. While Delta Dental has advised that it intends to renew the existing grant with Placer County, the grant documents have not yet been released, pending receipt of funding from the State. In order to minimize gaps in service delivery, Community Clinics has decided to move forward with the contract to KBFR implementing these services for FY 06-07 on a prospective basis.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This agreement is fully funded through the Delta Dental Healthy Families Rural Health Demonstration Project Grant. No County general fund contribution is required.
