ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$250 in Revenue Sharing monies to H. Clarke Powers Elementary School for the purchase of a new kiln, as requested by Supervisor Holmes (\$250).

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to support, through Revenue Sharing funds, the purchase of a new kiln for the art program at H. Clarke Powers Elementary School. The H. Clarke Powers Elementary School participates in the Placer County Art Docent Program, which includes art portfolios featuring famous pieces of art, art history lessons and a "hands-on" art history lesson. All of the Kindergarten through 8th grade students participate in the program. Volunteers organize the program and all materials are paid for by private donations.

Dear Supervisor Holmes:

It was a pleasure meeting you at the Loomis Chamber mixer in July. This letter (albeit late) is a follow-up to our conversation in which you expressed an interest in donating \$250 out of the revenue sharing account toward the purchase of a new kiln at H. Clarke Powers Elementary School.

To date, we have raised \$1,750 through donations from Exchange Bank, Irwin Union Bank and private donors. We need to raise a total of \$4,000 for the kiln and shipping. As you know, H. Clarke Powers is the only school in the Loomis Union School District without a kiln. With an active art program, more than 400 students would learn about clay, glazes and firing methods, encouraging creativity, curiosity and courage to try something new in a safe, structured environment.
