BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to support the wood duck nesting box program sponsored by the Sportsmen's Legacy Foundation. This is a two-part program prompted by the movement to preserve the population of wood ducks in the area through placement of wood duck nesting boxes in natural habitat settings and a natural history instructional component for Lincoln High School students. The students have the opportunity to earn scholarships worth \$500 each and over 50 students have been granted these scholarships to date. The funds designated towards this program will pay for the wood boxes.


Dear Mr. Santucci:
