BACKGROUND

The Placer Union High School District Theatre Creators held their Summer Theatre Academy camp from June 19th to June 30th 2006, at the Del Oro Performing Arts Center in Loomis. Theatre Creators, a volunteer group of parents, have been supplementing performing arts in the Placer County schools for over ten years. They create an intense, two-week performance camp which supports the skills, experience, and opportunities for young people wanting to enrich themselves with characteristics inherent in being healthy citizens and successful actors. The funds cover the budgeted expenses for the rights, rental and royalty for the production of the Broadway musical comedy, “The Apple Tree”.
