SUBJECT: Approve the request of the Roseville Joint Union High School District for a Special Bond Election and Authorize the County Clerk to render reimbursed election services

RECOMMENDATION

Approve the attached resolution calling an April 24, 2007 Special Bond Election as requested by the Roseville Joint Union High School District, authorizing the County Clerk to render reimbursed election services for the District.

BACKGROUND

Election Code Section 10002 and Education Code Section 5303 provide that the governing body of any school district may by resolution request the Board of Supervisors to conduct their elections and permit the County Clerk to render necessary election services to the district on a reimbursable basis.

The Roseville Joint Union High School District on January 16, 2007, adopted a resolution by their governing board, requesting the Placer County Clerk to conduct an April 24, 2007 Special Bond Election for the District.

In order for the Placer County Clerk to perform the election functions requested by the Roseville Joint Union High School District pursuant to Election Code Section 10002 Education Code Section 5303, the County Clerk must have the approval of your Board.

FISCAL IMPACT

The Roseville Joint Union High School District will pay the actual costs of the April 24, 2007 Special Bond Election as provided for in Election Code Section 10002 and in the approved fee schedule for election services set forth in County Code Section 2.116.140.A.
