SUBJECT: Authorize Supervisors Kranz, Holmes, Rockholm and Weygandt to travel to Washington DC

Action Requested:

Authorize Supervisors Kranz, Holmes, Rockholm and Weygandt to travel to Washington DC February 26 to March 1, 2007 to meet with elected or appointed officials from the United States to discuss legislative and regulatory issues affecting the county, and over which the federal officials have jurisdiction.

Background:

Annually, the Board of Supervisors approves a Legislative/Regulatory Platform that articulates the Board's proposals and priorities. During the February trip, Board members will meet with federal officials to discuss the following federal priorities:

- Continued funding for the Sub Regional Wastewater Treatment and Water Reclamation Facility;
- Continued funding for the Children's Health Center/Emergency Shelter;
- Additional funding for Law Enforcement Technology and Telecommunication Needs;
- Funding for Auburn-Folsom Road Widening;
- Continued funding for Walerga Road at Dry Creek Bridge Replacement;
- Continued support for Hazardous Materials Clean Up at DeWitt Center;
- Support for Reauthorization of the "Secure Rural Schools & Community Self-Determination Act of 2000";
- Funding for Wildfire Protection and Biomass Utilization;
- Funding for Kings Beach Commercial Core Improvement Corridor;
- Funding for the Placer Legacy program; and
- Funding for the Placer County Conservation Plan (PCCP) Phase 1.

Fiscal Impact:

The estimated travel, lodging and related incidental costs are estimated at approximately \$1,450 per Supervisor. The total estimated cost of \$5,800, for the Board members, is included in the FY 2006-07 budget.
