SUBJECT: REVENUE SHARING – Approve appropriation of \$1,700 in Revenue Sharing monies to The Placer Care Coalition, Inc. for the 7th Annual "Raising Spirits" Fundraiser as requested by Supervisor Rockholm (\$500), Supervisor Weygandt (\$500), Supervisor Holmes (\$200) and Supervisor Uhler (\$500).

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$1,700 in Revenue Sharing monies to The Placer Care Coalition, Inc. for the 7th Annual "Raising Spirits" Fundraiser as requested by Supervisor Rockholm (\$500), Supervisor Weygandt (\$500), Supervisor Holmes (\$200) and Supervisor Uhler (\$500).

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked once again to approve appropriations to help towards the costs of the Placer Care Coalition's 7th Annual "Raising Spirits" Fundraiser. The event will include wine tasting, food sampling, a silent and live auction and raffles. The Placer Care Coalition was formed in 2001, bringing together Roseville Homestart Inc., The Lazarus Project, St. Vincent de Paul Inc., What Would Jesus Do?, and Peace for Families. The Coalition is made up of representatives from the five agencies plus several at large members who reach out to all of South Placer County. The volunteer efforts of the Coalition help to benefit those in need within our community. Churches and other agencies, including police departments, refer people in need to the above five organizations to provide help. The funds designated towards this popular event will be divided evenly between the five agencies to help defray the cost of the many requests for help they receive throughout the year.

The Placer Care Coalition, Inc. is a non-profit organization that was formed in January 2001, bringing together Roseville Homestart Inc. (providing shelter for homeless families), the Lazarus Project Inc. (a transitional program for single adults), St. Vincent de Paul Inc. (providing social services, dining room, food locker, and thrift store for needy), What Would Jesus Do? (feeding the homeless and providing transportation), and Peace for Families (helping abused women & children). We are planning our seventh annual "Raising Spirits" food and wine sampling event, scheduled for May 6, 2007.

Our goal is to sell 500 tickets. The price of a ticket is \$40.00 or two for \$75.00. This price includes wine tasting and food sampling, all for the one price. There will also be a silent auction and live auction and raffles. The Placer Care Coalition, Inc. board is made up of representatives from the five agencies plus several at large members. Glenn Hofer is presently serving as president. The efforts of all these organizations reach out to all of South Placer County. There are no boundaries for the homeless. Churches and other agencies, including police departments, refer people in need to the above five organizations to provide help. The Coalition is made up of all volunteers who receive no salaries and thus we have no administration costs.
