
The Kings Beach Commercial Core Improvement Project (CCIP) is located on State Route 28 between State Route 267 and Chipmunk Street along the north shore of Lake Tahoe. The project scope developed by the Public Works Department includes improving pedestrian and bicyclist mobility, water quality of storm water runoff, public parking facilities, and aesthetics of the commercial core through the community of Kings Beach. The intent of the field tour is to visit the project site and visualize the proposed improvements as well as view completed and planned redevelopment efforts of the Redevelopment Agency (RDA) that are integral to the CCIP.

In addition, the tour will take the opportunity to visit other sites of interest including changeable message signs at the North Tahoe Fire Station at Kings Beach and potential Placer County government facility sites throughout the north shore region of the county.


The tour and schedule will occur as follows:
