SUBJECT: NO PARKING ON PFE ROAD AND COOK RIOLO ROAD

## **ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION**

Conduct a public hearing and Adopt an Ordinance establishing parking restrictions on portions of PFE Road and Cook Riolo Road.

## **BACKGROUND / SUMMARY**

PFE Road is an east-west roadway in the West Placer area. Cook Riolo Road is a north-south roadway in the same area (see map attached). Both roads serve rural single family residences in addition to local schools. Along both roadways, sufficient shoulder areas exist along PFE Road at Pinehurst Drive and Cook Riolo Road north of Jimmy Way, allowing vehicles to park.

The Department of Public Works periodically reviews the need for No Parking along County maintained roadways due to sight distance or other concerns. The Department has received several complaints from property owners through the West Placer Municipal Advisory Council concerning vehicles parked overnight in these areas. The MAC has proposed that No Parking Anytime be implemented on PFE Road west of Pinehurst Drive due to the existing bus stop and on Cook Riolo Road in front of the trail access. They have requested No Parking from 10 pm to 6 am for PFE road east of Pinehurst Drive and Cook Riolo Road north of Jimmy Way to prevent overnight parking.

DPW staff attended the March 8, 2007 West Placer Municipal Advisory Council Meeting. Based on input from the MAC, the department recommends that No Parking be implemented along PFE Road and Cook Riolo Road, and that the Board approve this Ordinance. The Ordinance will go into effect 30 days after adoption.

## **ENVIRONMENTAL**

This action is exempt under CEQA guidelines per Categorical Exemption 15301 (c) Class 1, Existing Facilities, and 15305 Class 5, Minor Alternations and Land Use Limitations. A Notice of Exemption was filed with the Placer County Planning Department and accepted on March 23, 2007.

## **FISCAL IMPACT**

The cost to place and maintain signs and curb markings is minimal and will be absorbed by the Road Fund.
