**SUBJECT:** RENAMING OF PUBLIC ROADWAYS – HIGHWAY 65 BYPASS PROJECT

**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Approve the renaming of four (4) existing sections of public roadways between Athens Avenue and northwest of the town of Sheridan and authorize the chairman to execute the attached resolution.

**BACKGROUND:**

In October 2005, Cal Trans requested that Placer County and the City of Lincoln provide road names for portions of the existing Highway 65 that will be relinquished by the California Department of Transportation (Cal Trans) as a result of their proposed Highway 65 bypass project. Although these road names will not be assigned until construction commences, Cal Trans requested them now in order to include them in their construction drawings. In addition, staff's research determined that several existing roads being impacted or severed by the proposed project will need to be assigned new names to provide efficient emergency services.

On October 19, 2006, the staff sent ballots to all the affected property owners within Placer County to vote on proposed road names for the portion of Highway 65 being relinquished to the County and the three other affected roadways. The following results are derived from the property owner's responses:

- "Lincoln Boulevard" for the portion of Industrial Boulevard from Athens Avenue to the Highway 65 bypass
- "Sheridan Lincoln Boulevard" for the portion of Highway 65 north of the City of Lincoln to Sheridan.
- "Wind Flower Place" for the separated north-south section of Riosa Road and North Dowd Road.
- "Townview Court" for the separated east-west section of Riosa Road.

Staff presented these road names to the Sheridan MAC on January 10, 2007 and the Lincoln MAC on January 22, 2007. Both MACs supported staff's recommended road names. These road names were considered by the Planning Commission at their February 22, 2007 hearing and the Commission unanimously recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve these road names.

On September 26, 2006, the City of Lincoln approved "Lincoln Boulevard" for the portion of Highway 65 that will be relinquished within the city limits.

**ENVIRONMENTAL:**

This is not a "project" as defined by CEQA.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

There is no fiscal impact for the renaming of existing public roads.

WHEREAS, the renaming of four (4) sections of existing public roadways is necessary as a result of the proposed Highway 65 bypass project, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.

WHEREAS, on the February 22, 2007 Planning Commission hearing, the Commission recommended that the Board of Supervisors approve the proposed road names.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors finds that the proposed road name assignments of "Lincoln Boulevard," "Sheridan Lincoln Boulevard," "Townview Court" and "Wind Flower Place" are not in conflict with the Placer County "Road Naming Policy" adopted by BOS Resolution 86-125.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors authorizes the Director of Engineering and Surveying to assign these road names when required and in conjunction with the Cal Trans Highway 65 Bypass project and the State's relinquishment of the existing Highway 65.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Placer, State of California that the Board hereby approves the road name assignments of "Lincoln Boulevard" between Athens Avenue and the proposed Highway 65 bypass, "Sheridan Lincoln Boulevard" for the relinquished portion of Highway 65 between the north city limit line of Lincoln to Sheridan, "Wind Flower Place" for the separated north-south section of Riosa Road and North Dowd Road and "Townview Court" for the separated east-west section of Riosa Road, as shown on the attached Exhibit A.
