BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

My name is Michael Verdooner and I am a member of Boy Scout Troop 12. For my Eagle project I am working with the members of my troop to construct a 9-hole frisbee golf course at H. Clarke Powers School, 3296 Humphrey Road, Loomis, CA 95650.
