SUBJECT: **Approve a Resolution authorizing the execution of a Service Provider Subgrant from the Golden Sierra Job Training Agency in the amount of \$50,000 to provide Layoff Aversion Services to Small Businesses in Placer County, approve a Budget Revision, and Authorize the County Executive Officer to execute any related documents or contracts**

ACTION REQUESTED

1. Approve a Resolution authorizing the execution of a Service Provider Subgrant from the Golden Sierra Job Training Agency in the amount \$50,000 to provide Layoff Aversion Services to Small Businesses in Placer County.
2. Approve a Budget Revision.
3. Authorize the County Executive Officer to execute any related documents or contracts.

BACKGROUND

The Golden Sierra Job Training Agency named Placer County as a Subgrantee in an application to the State Employment Development Department for grant funding and was awarded \$190,000 to fund the Layoff Aversion project from January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007. GSJTA has set aside \$50,000 in a Service Provider Subgrant for the Placer County Office of Economic Development and the office will use these funds to service and establish relationships with small businesses in the region by providing:

Layoff Aversion Services - by developing plans to identify and assist employers at risk of layoff due to competitive factors and establishing partnerships to gather information on changing workforce needs due to changes in the regional/local economy.

Innovation - Supporting innovative efforts to expand or redesign local Rapid Response systems to become more responsive to local businesses.

Small Business Services - by creating new ways to bring the One-Stop Career Center System to the small business employer.

Regional Impact - by supporting efforts to share innovative Rapid Response Service Models to the GSJTA and Workforce Investment Act and the wider Capitol Area Investment Zone Region.

ENVIRONMENT REVIEW

This action is exempt from CEQA Guidelines Section 15262 & 15306.

FISCAL IMPACT

These expenditures will be fully reimbursed by revenues so there will be not an impact to the General Fund.
