ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$250 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Del Oro High School *Safe and Sober Grad Night 2007* as requested by Supervisor Rockholm (\$150) and Supervisor Holmes (\$100).

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help support the Del Oro High School *Safe and Sober Grad Night 2007 Celebration*. The *Safe and Sober Grad Night* program began several years ago as a means to reduce alcohol related accidents on the evening of high school graduations.
