Subject: **APPROVAL OF CAMPUS AND STREET NAMES FOR THE SOUTH PLACER JUSTICE CENTER**

ACTION REQUESTED/RECOMMENDATION: Approve the name for the South Placer Justice Center in Roseville and three streets within the Center's campus.

BACKGROUND: On February 24, 2004, your Board approved the conceptual Master Plan for the development of the project currently referred to as the South Placer Justice Center. Subsequently, your Board approved the transaction documents necessary to proceed with acquisition of the property and construction of the Courthouse.

With the completion of the Courthouse Phase of this project planned for year end, the following actions are requested to formalize the naming of the Justice Center and the streets delineated in the Master Plan.

1. Designate the name the Justice Center complex as the "Placer County – Bill Santucci Justice Center" in honor of Mr. Santucci's 12 years of service as a Placer County Supervisor, in recognition of his long standing support of County justice services, and for his leadership in bringing the Justice Center project to fruition.
2. Designate the main entrance drive into the complex as "Justice Center Drive" to indicate the purpose of this complex to the public.
3. Designate the northerly access road, which provides secondary ingress and egress, as "Veterans Drive" in honor of all those who have served our country in the military services.
4. Designate the internal loop road as "Go For Broke Road" in honor of the 442nd Regimental Combat Team, the all Japanese-American combat regiment which was the most decorated unit for its size and length of service in the history of the U.S. Military.

These actions will provide formal approval of the naming conventions for the Justice Center as illustrated on the attached Master Site Plan. The Roseville Engineering Department has reviewed the proposed names and found no duplications or similar names for other streets.

ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE: Pursuant to Sec. 15378 of the CEQA Guidelines, this action is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act.

FISCAL IMPACT: There are no fiscal impacts associated with this action.


