SUBJECT: Partnership with Child Abuse Prevention Council and Operation of the Family Resource Centers

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve an agreement with Child Abuse Prevention Council of Placer County to provide child abuse prevention services and operation of the Family Resource Centers in the amount of \$390,000 for FY2007-08, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign subsequent amendments up to 10% of the total contract amount.

BACKGROUND:

The Child Abuse Prevention Council of Placer County (CAPC) continues to be a significant partner with Placer County Children's System of Care (CSOC) in providing State mandated education and prevention services for children and youth who are potential victims of abuse or neglect in Placer County.

This contract provides for the following services:

1. Operation of Family Resource Centers in Auburn, Roseville, and Colfax.
2. Supervised visitation and scheduling/coordination of Family Team Meetings.
3. Family support services, case management, and monitoring activities.

In FY2005-06, the last full year of operation, CAPC participated in over 35 community events reaching 3,500 Placer residents. These events provide child abuse prevention and awareness services, increase access to healthcare through health insurance enrollment, and a host of other prevention activities.

CAPC also operates neighborhood service centers located in three key geographic locations: Auburn, Roseville, and Colfax. During FY2005-06, CAPC provided services to 847 adults and 761 children through the Family Resource Centers.

Through the effective services coordinated CAPC, over 500 children and families have been able to maintain self-sufficiency and prevented abuse and neglect that would have required further involvement with the child welfare system.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total cost of this contract is included in the FY2007-08 proposed budget. Contract expenditures consist of \$320,000 in state and federal funding, \$37,000 funded by Children's Trust Fund revenues, and \$33,000 in required matching County General Funds.
