BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked once again to approve appropriations to help support the Boys & Girls Club of Auburn. The Boys & Girls Club of Auburn provides a Summer Camp for Auburn's children each year. The program offers children a safe place to be, providing supervision, positive activities and adult mentors for seven weeks. The Boys & Girls Club of Auburn is currently serving four hundred and ninety three children. The funds designated towards this popular program will help defray the costs of the supplies needed to run the program.

Dear Jim,

As you know, the Boys & Girls Club of Auburn provides a Summer Camp for Auburn's children each year. Last year we had 493 children attend for seven weeks at a cost of \$85,012 or \$24.63 per week, per child. They participated in recreation, field trips, swimming, art and many other activities and were given lunch and snacks daily. I am enclosing a copy of my report to the Teichert Foundation for your information.

The expenses were covered by the Kids' Benefit Breakfast \$62,000; Teichert Foundation \$5,000; Sacramento River Cats \$2,000 and individual community members and businesses who sponsored children.

We think we can deliver the same services this Summer for the same per child cost. We have made many personal requests to community members but think we are going to be \$10,000 short of our projected cost.

Please accept this letter as a request for financial support to help us continue the Summer Camp Program.
