ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution accepting the subject project as complete and authorizing the Director of Public Works to execute the Notice of Completion.

BACKGROUND

The Board authorized the award of Construction Contract No. 73236 to Granite Construction Company for the amount of \$2,096,096 and authorized the Director of Public Works to execute Contract Change Orders up to 15% of the contract amount. Work on this Contract was complete on August 22, 2007. The purpose of this project was to replace the existing bridge superstructure on Squaw Valley Road over Squaw Creek.

ENVIRONMENTAL

This project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15302 – Class 2. A Notice of Exemption was filed with the Placer County Recorder on January 10, 2005 and no comments were received during the public comment period. A Programmatic Categorical Exclusion was also received from Caltrans for the NEPA (National Environmental Protection Act) process on December 22, 2004.

FISCAL IMPACT

The construction contract was awarded for \$2,096,096.00. The Department has determined the final estimated construction cost for this project was \$2,105,237.79. There was 1 Contract Change Order (CCO) issued during this project amounting to \$7,355.79. Contract data and CCO summaries are attached as Exhibit "A". The project was funded through the Federal HBRR Program (88.53%) and County Traffic Mitigation Fees and Road Funds (11.47%). Funding for construction of the project was included in the 2005/2006, 2006/2007 and 2007/2008 Fiscal Year Budget.
