BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.


The event will be a Casino Night at the Turkey Creek Golf Course Clubhouse on Nov. 10, 2007. I am enclosing an information sheet for you to look over.
