**SUBJECT:** Grant Agreement with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

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**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Approve the renewal grant agreement with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to receive funds for Permanent Supportive Housing under the Supportive Housing Program in the amount of \$293,282. The term of the agreement is for twelve months, beginning upon execution; the funding provides on-going housing and self-sufficiency services to the homeless, mentally ill population.

**BACKGROUND:**

Each year this Permanent Supportive Housing grant contributes to the reduction of homelessness for those with mental illness in Placer County by providing rental subsidies. In addition to housing, the goal is to assist individuals in achieving self-sufficiency through employment and community resource development.

Currently there are 20 single adults and 11 adults in families benefiting from this housing service. This is the fifth year that Placer County has received this Housing and Urban Development grant funding, and it will continue to improve housing options for homeless persons receiving services from the Adult System of Care.

This award is for a twelve-month period that begins upon execution of the agreement. Existing staff (1.3 FTE) will continue to be assigned to this program.

This grant was reviewed and recommended for approval by the Mental Health, Alcohol, and Drug Advisory Board at its regular meeting on November 26.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

This renewal grant is at the same level of funding as the previous fiscal year. The required County match of \$28,936 is a General Fund contribution, and is included in the FY 07/08 budget. The match requirement represents the cost of clerical and administrative support for the program.
