

**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS:** In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

Dear Supervisor <sup>Jim</sup> Holmes:

It was good to see you at the Jefferson/Jackson Dinner last month. It never ceases to amaze me where I run into you – as many people I know say about you: “He’s everywhere!” What a great example for a public official to exhibit to the community – involvement is important!

My principal purpose for writing this letter is to thank you and the Board of Supervisors for its past support of our non-profit, all volunteer music education/cultural enhancement programs. As you know, the ACCA is the longest-lived community service program in Auburn; it began its service to the greater Auburn area more than 62 years ago. The ACCA provides high-quality musical performances to families in this area with a series of concerts each year. Many of the nationally-recognized musical artists that we bring to the community are able to conduct educational programs and/or master’s classes for area school students in order to promote classical and other forms of traditional music. This year we provided for the music and art students at Placer High School an instructional session with the Jeni Fleming Trio, a jazz group. Contributors in the top categories are recognized not only in the initial concert program, but also in each performance program for the rest of the season. It is an opportunity for you and your colleagues to assist residents of District 3 (and the entire County) by becoming a partner in the cultural enhancement of the greater Auburn and South Placer region.
