BACKGROUND

The Board is being asked to approve a Commendation honoring Sergeant Scott Jones #9136 for nearly 30 years of service to the great people of the State of California as a California Highway Patrol Officer. Sergeant Jones first entered the CHP Academy in May of 1978. Upon his successful graduation, Officer Jones was assigned to the Redwood City Office. He was promoted to Sergeant in August of 1989. Throughout his career, he has worked in Redwood City, Hayward and Newhall before transferring to Gold Run in August of 1999 where he has served the remainder of his career.

WHEREAS, after serving in the Newhall office for two years, Scott transferred back to the Hayward office on January 1, 1992; and

WHEREAS, upon his return to the Hayward office, Sergeant Jones completed the CHP Motorcycle Training course and served that unit from January 14, 1993 to August 1999; and

WHEREAS, in August 1999, Scott transferred to the Gold Run Area office where he has served the remainder of his career; and

WHEREAS, Scott has been supported through the years by his wife Lillian and children Jeff, Jennifer and Dillon; and

WHEREAS, Sergeant Scott Jones has impacted the lives of many people through his service as a California Highway Patrol Officer and he has received numerous commendations for his performance and favorable letters from the motoring public as a result of the outstanding service he has provided.
