SUBJECT: PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT FOR PAINT TESTING SERVICES FOR THE FORESTHILL ROAD BRIDGE REPAINTING PROJECT, CONTRACT NO. 1043

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Chairman of the Board to execute a Professional Services Agreement with KTA-Tator Inc., in a total amount of \$76,000 for paint testing services for the Foresthill Road Bridge Repainting Project and authorize the Director of Public Works to approve and sign contract amendments for additional professional services not to exceed \$15,000.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

Public Works is proposing to repaint the Foresthill Road Bridge which has not been painted since it was constructed in the early 1970's. The entire bridge needs to be painted to avoid further deterioration. The project is being completed under the Federal Highway Bridge Program (HBP).

The Department of Public Works (DPW) developed a Request for Proposals (RFP) for Paint Testing Services with the intent of retaining services to evaluate the existing conditions of the paint system. The RFP was advertised by notifying six firms specializing in paint and coating testing and evaluation. Two consultants submitted proposals in response to our RFP. A four member panel consisting of DPW staff and Caltrans staff determined that KTA-Tator, Inc. was the highest rated firm.

ENVIRONMENTAL

This Professional Services agreement is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines, Section 15306. This action is not a project as defined in Section 21065 of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and therefore is exempt from CEQA, because these contracts do not commit the County to any definite course of action that could impact the physical environment.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total cost of Paint Testing Services for these projects is \$76,000. Preliminary Engineering of the project is funded through the Federal HBP Program (80%) and County Road Fund (20%). There are sufficient funds available in the proposed 2008/2009 Fiscal Year Budget.
