SUBJECT: Approve the Renewal of Blanket Purchase Order No. BP015194 as a Result of Competitive Bid No. 9606 for Local Pharmacy Services to Rite Aid Corp. in the Maximum Amount of \$75,000.00

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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve the renewal of Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) No. 15194 as a result of Competitive Bid No. 9606 for local pharmacy services to Rite Aid Corp. of Camp Hill, PA in the maximum amount of \$75,000.00, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BPO.

**BACKGROUND**

On September 26, 2006, your Board approved an award from competitive Bid No. 9606 to Rite Aid Corp. on behalf of Health & Human Services Adult System of Care and the Medical Care Services Program. On October 2, 2007, your Board approved the first renewal of this contract with Rite Aid Corp. resulting in the award of BP015194 in the maximum amount of \$63,000 for local pharmacy services.

HHS has requested the renewal of BP015194 in the maximum amount of \$75,000.00 and Rite Aid Corp. has agreed to the one-year renewal with no changes in pricing or terms.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

With your Board's approval, the BPO resulting from this recommendation will be awarded to Rite Aid Corp. in the maximum amount of \$75,000.00 and will be effective from October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009. Health & Human Services' Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.

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HHS' Community Health & Clinics Division has budgeted appropriately for renewal of this \$75,000 Blanket Purchase Order (which is \$12,000 higher than the previous BPO), and funding for the first nine months is available in the Proposed FY2008-2009 Base Budget. The final three months of the BPO period will be included in the Division's FY2009-2010 Budget. These services are for eligible recipients in the County's mandated Medical Care Services Program, which is 100% funded with County General Fund.
