SUBJECT: Adopt a Resolution Approving the 2008 Annual Report of the Redevelopment Agency.

ACTION REQUESTED: Adopt a resolution approving the 2008 Annual Report of the Redevelopment Agency (Agency).

BACKGROUND: The State of California requires the Agency to prepare an annual report. A redevelopment agency must present to its legislative body the annual report within six months of the end of the agency's fiscal year (California Health & Safety Code, Section 33080.1). The annual report consists of an independent audit report for the previous fiscal year, a description of the Agency's activities affecting housing and displacement, a blight progress report, a copy of the annual report to the State Controller, a loan report, and a property report.

DISCUSSION: An independent financial audit report of the Agency for Fiscal Year 2007-2008 has been conducted. The Audit Report is included in the 2008 Annual Report of the Agency. The Independent Auditor's Report includes the reports of the accounting firm of Gilbert Associates, Inc., CPA's whose "unqualified opinion" is contained therein. They disclosed no instances of noncompliance with California Community Redevelopment Law. The report is circulated to investors in Agency bonds, rating agencies, insurers, and other parties interested in the Agency's financial status. It is also reproduced in official statements for future bond issues. This is the tenth consecutive year that the Agency has received a clean audit from the independent auditor.

FISCAL IMPACT: There is no fiscal impact to the Agency or the County.

RECOMMENDATION: Adopt a resolution approving the 2008 Annual Report of the Agency.

WHEREAS, the planning and administrative expenses for the redevelopment low- and moderate-income funds were necessary to support the production, improvement, and preservation of low- and moderate-income housing during the 2007-2008 Fiscal Year;

WHEREAS, the expenditures for public improvements in the 2007-2008 Fiscal Year are of benefit to the Agency's respective redevelopment project areas in and near where such improvements will be constructed;

WHEREAS, such improvements will help to alleviate blighting conditions in the applicable project areas; and
