**SUBJECT:** Change Orders to Blanket Purchase Orders with Radiological Associates of Sacramento for Radiological Diagnostic and Imaging Services

**ACTION REQUESTED:**

Approve and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the following change orders:

- a. Change Order No. 1 to Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) No. 15189 with Radiological Associates of Sacramento for radiological imaging studies and diagnostic services for the period of October 1, 2007 through September 30, 2008, increasing the maximum amount by \$32,000 for a revised maximum amount of \$232,000, and
- b. Change Order No. 1 to BPO No. 16197 with Radiological Associates of Sacramento for radiological imaging studies and diagnostic services for the period of October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009, increasing the maximum amount by \$25,000 for a revised maximum amount of \$245,000, and clarifying that Placer County will only pay for services that have received prior or retroactive authorization.

These services are fully funded with County General Funds and the costs for services provided during 2008/09 are reflected in the 2008/09 Final Budget.

**BACKGROUND:**

Placer County Community Clinics (PCCC) provides cost-effective medical services to over 900 patients enrolled in the County's Medical Care Services Program (MCSP). The adults eligible for this program have no other funding or insurance for their needed medical care, and they typically earn less than \$865 monthly. The number of MCSP enrollees has increased 14% since October 2007, in part as a result of the economic downturn. Radiological diagnostic and imaging services, such as x-rays, ultrasound, mammograms, nuclear medicine, MRIs and fluoroscopy procedures, are provided to PCCC patients by Radiological Associates of Sacramento (RAS). These services are provided at several RAS outpatient locations, including Auburn Imaging and Roseville Imaging, and within nearby hospitals. Fees paid to RAS are based on current Medi-Cal rates.

Due to the increased number of MCSP patients, and the resulting increased number of cases referred for radiological services, the requested change order adjustments are necessary to provide sufficient funding for these BPOs with RAS.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

These services are associated with the County's mandated Medical Care Services Program which is 100% funded through the County General Fund. Funding for costs related to these change orders for 2008/09 is included in the Department's 2008/09 Final Budget. Costs related to services to be provided after June 30, 2009 will be included in the 2009/10 Budget.
