SUBJECT: Intensive Outpatient Addiction Recovery Services for Children

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve an agreement with Full Circle Treatment Center to provide addiction recovery services from August 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009 in the amount of \$45,000, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the agreement and subsequent amendments up to 10% of the total contract amount. A County General Fund contribution of \$11,000, already contained in the Department's current year approved budget is required.

BACKGROUND:

CSOC has historically delivered addiction recovery services through a network of contracted providers in the community. Full Circle Treatment Center recently opened for services, and is currently the only provider offering intensive outpatient adolescent addiction recovery of treatment.

Approval of this agreement will allow up to 12 Placer youth to receive these services in the current fiscal year. Without these services, these youth are likely to require group home or out-of-state care. With this service, expected County cost avoidance for the first year of this agreement is approximately \$195,000.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The allocations for this contract are unused contracted dollars, which will be unspent elsewhere. The cost of this contract has been budgeted in the Children's System of Care fiscal year 2008-2009 Final Budget. Funding includes \$33,000 of State dollars and a County General Fund match of \$11,000.
