SUBJECT: CALIFORNIA TAHOE CONSERVANCY PUBLIC ACCESS AND RECREATION PROGRAM SITE IMPROVEMENT GRANT APPLICATION FOR THE TAHOE CITY TRANSIT CENTER

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## ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution approving the preparation and submittal of a California Tahoe Conservancy (CTC) Public Access and Recreation Program site improvement grant application for the bicycle trail components of the Tahoe City Transit Center in the amount of \$200,000 and authorize the Director of Public Works to execute all subsequent CTC grant documents.

## BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

In order to promote public access and recreation improvement projects in the Lake Tahoe Basin, the CTC has developed a site improvement grant component to their Public Access and Recreation Program that covers project implementation costs. Placer County is requesting funding up to \$200,000 to fund the bicycle trail components of the Tahoe City Transit Center. The CTC requires a resolution of approval by the governing body as part of the site improvement grant application package, which is scheduled for approval in March 2009.

## ENVIRONMENTAL

The CEQA documentation has been completed for the project, which includes the May 2000 Draft Environmental Impact Report/Statement/Statement (EIR/S/S); August 2000 Final EIR/S/S; June 2005 Draft Recirculated Environmental Impact Report (REIR); and September 2005 Final REIR. The Board of Supervisors certified the Final REIR and adopted a statement of findings regarding the Tahoe City Transit Center on January 24, 2006.

## FISCAL IMPACT

Placer County is requesting up to \$200,000 of Public Access and Recreation Program site improvement grant funding for construction of the bicycle trail components of the Tahoe City Transit Center; total project cost is \$8,500,000. The CTC grant approval is scheduled for March 2009; funding for this project is budgeted in the Fiscal Year 2008-09 budget and proposed for FY2009-10 and does not require match funding by the CTC.
