SUBJECT: Approve the Award of a Blanket Purchase Order as a Result of an El Dorado County Competitively Awarded Contract to Pervo Paint Company for Waterborne Traffic Line Paint for Road Maintenance in the Maximum Amount of \$160,000.00

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the award of a Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) as a result of an El Dorado County competitively awarded contract to Pervo Paint Company of Los Angeles, CA for waterborne traffic line paint for road maintenance in the maximum amount of \$160,000.00, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BPO.

BACKGROUND

The Department of Public Works, Road Maintenance Division (DPW), requires an annual agreement for the purchase of waterborne traffic line paint. On February 24, 2009, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors approved the purchase of waterborne traffic line paint, as a result of the county's competitive Bid No. 09-289-069, to Pervo Paint Company of Los Angeles. DPW requested to purchase waterborne traffic line paint utilizing the same pricing as the County of El Dorado. In accordance with the Purchasing Policy Manual Section 1.3 (e)(3), County policy permits contracting with a vendor that was awarded an agreement by another public agency as the result of a competitive process without further competitive bidding by Placer County. Procurement Services determined that the El Dorado contract offers pricing approximately nine percent less than pricing available from a similar State of California contract. Procurement has concluded that it is very unlikely that a bid solicitation at this time would result in prices below the County's total cost to award a BPO based on El Dorado County's contract.

FISCAL IMPACT

The BPO resulting from this recommendation will be effective for the period April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2010 in the maximum amount of \$160,000.00. DPW's Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.
