**ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION**

Approve the project plans and specifications for use in bidding and construction of the Lake Forest Erosion Control Project - Area B (SEZ/Habitat Restoration) and authorize the Department to advertise for bids once all funding is secured.

**BACKGROUND / SUMMARY**

The Lake Forest Erosion Control Project - Area B (SEZ/Habitat Restoration) is located on the north shore of Lake Tahoe approximately two miles east of Tahoe City.

The proposed construction will restore 35 acres of stream environment zone and provide treatment for storm water runoff within the project limits. Proposed improvements include grading, culverts, channel stabilization, floodplain creation, and revegetation on public properties owned by various state agencies. This portion of the project is Phase 1. Phase 1 will provide treatment of storm water runoff from public right-of-way improvements that are part of Phases 2 and 3 of the project within the Lake Forest neighborhood.

The project is identified in the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency's Environmental Improvement Program (EIP) as Project EIP No. 649, 944, 1004, 10041, 10142, 10143, and 10144.

**ENVIRONMENTAL**


The County prepared a Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) pursuant to the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the Placer County Environmental Review Ordinance. The MND (State Clearinghouse No - 2008122067) was approved by the Board of Supervisors on February 24, 2009.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The total project cost is estimated to be \$12,500,000 with construction costs for Phase 1 estimated at \$4,000,000. The project is fully funded through grants from the United States Forest Service, United States Army Corps of Engineers, and the California Tahoe Conservancy. Funding for the construction of this project is included in the 2009-10 Fiscal Year Budget.


