SUBJECT: SUNSET BOULEVARD/STATE ROUTE 65 INTERCHANGE – WATER MAIN
RELOCATION AGREEMENT

ACTION REQUESTED / RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the Chairman of the Board to execute the Construction Cooperative Agreement for the Sunset Boulevard/State Route 65 Interchange between Placer County Water Agency (PCWA) and Placer County.

BACKGROUND / SUMMARY

The Department of Public Works (DPW) is replacing the current at-grade signalized intersection with a grade-separated partial cloverleaf interchange with a six lane over-crossing at Sunset Blvd and State Route 65. The project will reduce traffic congestion, accidents and delays. The project will allow for the future expansion of State Route 65 to eight lanes with auxiliary lanes and will accommodate the increased traffic demand generated by existing and future development in south Placer County.

On January 12, 2009, the County awarded the construction contract to RGW Construction. The Notice to Proceed was issued to RGW and construction began on March 16, 2009. The project construction period is estimated to take between 18-24 months.

The relocation of PCWA's 24" diameter water main into the bridge structure is an essential element of the project. The relocation provides a complete facility capable of sustaining future area development. A Cooperative Agreement regarding the relocation of the water main was prepared and reviewed for this project by DPW and County Counsel and subsequently reviewed and accepted by PCWA. PCWA Board of Directors approved the Cooperative Agreement on March 19, 2009. The Cooperative Agreement between DPW and PCWA is a cost sharing agreement for the relocation of an existing 24 inch diameter water main during the construction phases of the Sunset Boulevard/State Route 65 Interchange. The agreement outlines the responsibilities of each signee and their financial obligation.

ENVIRONMENTAL

The Placer County BOS approved the Mitigated Negative Declaration for this project and a Notice of Determination was filed on May 23, 2006.

FISCAL IMPACT

The total construction cost for the relocation is \$366,960.00. The County will be responsible for half of the total construction cost including half of all contract change orders associated with the water main relocation. The funding for this project will come from County Traffic Impact Fees and the Highway 65 Joint Powers Authority. Funding for the project is included in the 2008/2009 Fiscal Year Budget.
