Recommendation

Approve the attached resolution calling an August 25, 2009 all-mail ballot Special Election as requested by the City of Rocklin and authorizing the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to render reimbursed election services for the Special Election to be held August 25, 2009

Background

Elections Code Sections 10002 and 4000 provide that the governing body of a city may by resolution request the Board of Supervisors to conduct its elections by all-mail ballot and permit the County elections official to render necessary election services to the city on a reimbursable basis.

On May 12, 2009, the City Council of the City of Rocklin adopted a resolution requesting the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to conduct an August 25, 2009 all mail ballot Special Election for the City.

In order for the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to perform the election functions requested by the City of Rocklin pursuant to Elections Code Sections 10002 and 4000, the County Registrar of Voters must have the approval of your Board.

Fiscal Impact

The City of Rocklin will pay for the actual costs of the special election as provided for in Election Code Section 10002 and in the approved fee schedule for election services set forth in Placer County Code Section 2.116.140.A, including for costs incurred specifically for the election.

WHEREAS, the City of Rocklin has ordered a Special Municipal Election to be conducted as an all-mail ballot election, to be held in their jurisdiction on August 25, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the wording for said measure has been delivered to the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters and is presented to the Placer County Board of Supervisors as Exhibit A (see attached); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 10002 and 4000 of the Elections Code, the Governing Body of the City may request the Placer County Board of Supervisors to call elections and permit the County elections official to render specified services to said Body relating to the conduct of elections on a reimbursable basis.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Placer County Board of Supervisors that the City of Rocklin all-mail ballot Special Election shall be held on August 25, 2009; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED that the Board of Supervisors of the County of Placer hereby authorizes the Placer County Clerk-Recorder-Registrar of Voters to render any and all necessary election services to the City for said special election and to receive reimbursement for the costs incurred.
