SUBJECT: Approve the Award of a Purchase Order as a Result of a City of Roseville Competitively Awarded Contract with Riverview International Trucks, LLC for One Truck Mounted Vactor 2105 Series Combination Catch Basin/Sewer Cleaner in the Amount of \$365,902.50

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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve the award of a purchase order (PO) as a result of a City of Roseville competitively awarded contract with Riverview International Trucks, LLC of West Sacramento for one truck mounted Vactor 2105 Series combination catch basin/sewer cleaner in the amount of \$365,902.50, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting PO.

**BACKGROUND**

On December 10, 2008, the Roseville City Council approved the purchase of one truck mounted Vactor combination catch basin/sewer cleaner, as a result of the city's competitive Request for Quote 1879, from Riverview International Trucks, LLC in the amount of \$362,505.00. Riverview's bid was the lowest priced of three bids received by Roseville. The Placer County Facility Services Department, Environmental Engineering Division, requested to purchase one 5-yard combo Vactor unit, like the unit purchased by the City of Roseville, using pricing from the City of Roseville contract. This vehicle will be used to maintain the collection pipes in the County's sewer lines, to clean the County's sewer lift stations, and for responding to emergencies such as sewer spills or customer service calls. Riverview International Trucks submitted a proposal in the amount of \$365,902.50 for the requested unit which is the same price paid by Roseville plus the recent one percent increase in sales tax. In accordance with the Purchasing Policy Manual Section 1.3 (e)(3), County policy permits contracting with a vendor that was awarded an agreement by another public agency as the result of a competitive process without further competitive bidding by Placer County.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The purchase order resulting from this recommendation will total \$365,902.50. Facility Services' Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.
