Subject: **EMERGENCY PURCHASE ORDER - RAMOS ENVIRONMENTAL SERVICES**

ACTION REQUESTED/RECOMMENDATION : It is recommended that your Board ratify the emergency purchase of services for pumping and disposal of contaminated water/sludge by Ramos Environmental Services for the amount of \$6,103.75.

BACKGROUND: On June 8, 2009, Facility Services staff discovered old fuel oil in a sump mixed with run off water and sludge. This incident was located adjacent to Building 302 in the Placer County Government Center. To avoid contamination of down stream storm drains, Facility Services contacted Ramos Environmental Services to extract liquid and sludge. In compliance with environmental procedures, it was necessary to provide an experienced company licensed and certified for clean up and disposal of the waste material.

ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE: Waste material was disposed of in compliance with all applicable laws and regulations. A Uniform Hazardous Waste Manifest was issued to Placer County from Veolia ES Technical Solutions, LLC, 1125 Hensley Street, Richmond CA 94801, #005486591JJK.

FISCAL IMPACT: The \$6,103.75 was funded by the DeWitt Enterprise Fund. Therefore, approval of this request will have no impact upon the County General Fund.
