SUBJECT: HIV/AIDS Program Services for FY 2009-10

ACTION REQUESTED:

Approve an agreement with Sierra Foothills AIDS Foundation for services to individuals with HIV/AIDS from July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 in an amount not to exceed \$247,237, and authorize the Director of Health and Human Services to sign the resulting contract and amendments up to 10 percent of the total contract amount. No County General Fund contribution is required. These costs are included in the Department's FY 2009-10 Proposed Budget.

BACKGROUND:

Placer County has contracted for the provision of HIV/AIDS program services with Sierra Foothills AIDS Foundation that, for the last twelve years, has successfully provided case management and other services. This funding will provide services for over 200 clients having complex needs, working to improve or maintain their health and well-being and prevent the further spread of HIV in the community. Services include medical case management, mental health therapy, basic dental services, transportation services, referrals to HIV testing, counseling, and drug treatment or other risk reduction services to prevent transmission of HIV. This approach gives consumers a "one-stop shop" with a comprehensive integrated service approach.

FISCAL IMPACT:

These expenditures are funded with 100 percent federal funds. These costs are included in the Department's FY 2009-10 Proposed Budget. No County General Funds are required.
