SUBJECT: Approve the Renewal of Negotiated Blanket Purchase Order No. BP016197 with Radiological Associates of Sacramento for Radiology Services in the Maximum Amount of \$245,000.00

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the renewal of negotiated Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) No. BP016197 with Radiological Associates of Sacramento (RAS) for radiology services, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting blanket purchase order in the maximum amount of \$245,000.00.

BACKGROUND

The Health and Human Services' (HHS) Managed Care/Medically Indigent Adult (MIA) program requires an annual contract for diagnostic radiology services when these services cannot be performed at County medical clinics. The radiology services may include x-rays, ultrasound, mammography, nuclear medicine, MRIs and/or fluoroscopy. These services are available at several RAS locations including Auburn Imaging, Roseville Imaging, or at various hospitals, which are in close proximity to the County's medical clinics. The prices charged for these services are based on the current Medi-Cal rates. On September 23, 2008, your Board approved BP016197 in the maximum amount of \$220,000.00 for the time period of October 1, 2008 through September 30, 2009. On January 13, 2009, your Board approved Change Order No. 1 to BP016197, increasing the maximum amount of the BPO by \$25,000.00. HHS has requested to renew the existing BPO for another year in the maximum amount of \$245,000.00. RAS has agreed to renew at the same price and terms as the current agreement.

County policy authorizes this renewal in accordance with Purchasing Policy Manual (PPM) Sections 1.3(a), which exempts professional services which involve extended analysis from competition, and PPM 7.2, which allows the award of blanket purchase orders for operational services based on geographical location(s) to the County's site(s) of operations.

FISCAL IMPACT

HHS has requested a BPO in the maximum amount of \$245,000.00 to be effective from October 1, 2009, through September 30, 2010. Health & Human Services' Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.

The department has budgeted appropriately for the renewal of this \$245,000 Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) and funding for the first nine months is available in the Proposed FY2009-2010 Budget. The final three months of the BPO will be included in the FY2010-2011 Budget. The renewal amount is the same as the current BPO in place with Radiological Associates. Radiological imaging services are provided to eligible recipients in the County's mandated Medical Care Services Program, which is funded 100% by the County General Fund.
