**Subject:** Recommendation to Purchase of Interview Recording Equipment

**ACTION REQUESTED**

Your approval is requested to purchase new interview equipment in the amount of \$19,989.02 for the Multi-Disciplinary Interview Center (MDIC). Your approval is also requested to modify the Master Fixed Asset List, for the attached budget revision in the amount of \$11,508.01, plus additional costs in the amount of \$8,481.01 necessary for systems integration, engineering, project management, commissioning and project administrative support, and to authorize the Purchasing Manager to execute any related purchasing documents. The cost of the equipment is included in the Fiscal 09/10 budget with no additional impact to the General Fund.

**BACKGROUND**

In 1993, MDIC was opened and operated under the administrative direction and operational assistance of the Child Abuse Prevention Council of Placer County. In October, 1998, the administrative responsibility of operating MDIC shifted to the Placer County District Attorney's Office due to the Child Abuse Prevention Council's tremendous growth and focus on prevention and early intervention services.

The children's interview center works to address the most fragile of our population and stop offenders from re-offending through quality investigation and successful prosecution. With the creation of Placer County MDIC, child victims of abuse in Placer County are interviewed, one time, by a trained specialist in a child-friendly setting. Children's trauma is reduced, the truth-finding process enhanced, and successful prosecution increased to remove abusers from our streets.

The purchase of new interview equipment will help to aid in the comfort of the child and assist in the investigation and prosecution of some of the most heinous crimes in our county: child sexual predators.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The cost of the equipment is included in the Fiscal 09/10 budget with no additional impact to the General Fund.
