ACTION REQUESTED

Approve appropriation of \$550 in Revenue Sharing monies to the Child Advocates of Placer County *Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) Program* benefit this child abuse prevention program, as requested by Supervisor Rockholm (\$150), Supervisor Weygandt (\$200) and Supervisor Holmes (\$200).

BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS: In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked once again to approve appropriations to help fund the Child Advocates of Placer County *Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) Program*. The primary function of Child Advocates of Placer County is to administer the *Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) Program* for Placer County. The CASA program, recruit, train, and supervise community volunteers who advocate for the best interests of abused, neglected, and/or abandoned children in the Placer County Dependency Court and ensure they are placed in a safe, permanent living situation. The funds designated towards this program will help offset the cost associated with recruiting and training new CASA volunteers, and providing supervision and continuing training for all of the CASA volunteers, as well as printing training materials, hosting training events, meeting with Court personnel and County social workers, and various personnel costs.

Funds are available in the Revenue Sharing budget.
