SUBJECT: REVENUE SHARING – Approve a total appropriation of \$5,150 in District 5 Revenue Sharing Funds (Benefit Grant Funds) to the attached list of nonprofit organizations and events recommended by the Citizens District 5 Benefit Fund Committee: SnowFest (\$1,000), Hebrew Congregation Holiday Food and Clothing Project (\$1,000), Kings Beach Library Friends DVD/CD Carousel Matching Fund (\$500), North Tahoe Business Association Leadership Program Partial Scholarships (\$750), Dutch Flat Community Center Children's Fund Vouchers (\$1,000) and Operation MOM Overseas Troop Services (\$900).

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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve a total appropriation of \$5,150 in District 5 Revenue Sharing Funds (Benefit Grant Funds) to the attached list of nonprofit organizations and events recommended by the Citizens District 5 Benefit Fund Committee: SnowFest (\$1,000), Hebrew Congregation Holiday Food and Clothing Project (\$1,000), Kings Beach Library Friends DVD/CD Carousel Matching Fund (\$500), North Tahoe Business Association Leadership Program Partial Scholarships (\$750), Dutch Flat Community Center Children's Fund Vouchers (\$1,000), Operation MOM Overseas Troop Services (\$900).

**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS:**

Supervisor Montgomery directed that a citizens committee be established for the purpose of reviewing and making recommendations on the distribution of revenue sharing funds to various community organizations. The committee has undertaken its evaluation and has come forward with a list of recommendations to your Board from applications received on behalf of various community groups and interests within District 5.

**DISTRICT 5 BENEFIT COMMITTEE**

Following notices and publicity informing the public of the process and seeking interested citizens, the District 5 Benefit Fund Committee was formed. In addition, to

assist the committee in its task of review and evaluation, a list of committee procedures and categories of evaluation was developed. Currently, the District 5 Benefit Committee is comprised of six members; Megan Chillemi, Emily Wexler, Wally Reemlin, Ann Brown, Ken Baughman and Bob Houston. Posting of the meeting of the committee occurred at the Placer County Administrative Offices, 175 Fulweiler Avenue, Auburn and on the Supervisor Jennifer Montgomery Event Calendar on the County Website. A meeting was held on Monday, December 7, 2009 at 11:00 a.m. with Megan Chillemi, Bob Houston, Anne Brown, and Ken Baughman. They voted to recommend the distribution of District 5 Revenue Sharing funds to six different entities in a total amount of \$5,150.

In approving revenue sharing contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

Let me begin by thanking you in advance for taking your time to read this letter and consider our request.

The Holiday Food and Clothing Project gathers food and clothing each year for those families in need in our North Lake Tahoe community, and distributes that food and clothing on the Saturday before Christmas Eve, so that all families from Tahoma to Kings Beach can enjoy a hearty Christmas dinner and have warm clothing for the winter. The project typically supplies over 21,000 pounds of food to over 1000 people, and last year the distribution provided over 25,000 pounds of food to over 1500 residents of the North and West shores of Lake Tahoe. This December, we expect to have a greater need in our community, and are budgeting to feed up to 2000 people.

This year, probably because of the difficulties in our economy, our income from donations is less than in the past, and the need in our community for our services is greater. For those reasons, we are asking for a donation from your Fund of \$1000. This will be used to purchase food for the distribution day. We buy our food through the Food Bank in Reno, Nevada at greatly reduced prices.

The total estimated budget for our Project this year is \$6888. All of that money goes to the purchase of food and supplies for the event. All of the services are provided by volunteers. There is no overhead and no salaries to be paid out of this budget.

This program provides an opportunity in our community to serve others. Half of the 150 volunteers that work on this project are children and teenagers from the Incline Village and North Tance schools. They sort food, call the recipients regarding the distribution date and times for food pickup, collect warm clothing, pick up day old bakery goods from our local stores, load and unload trucks with food from the Food Bank, and learn what it is like to make other people happy when they see the faces of the recipients on distribution day. The volunteers help the recipients load carts with food, and take the food to their cars, and even deliver the food and clothing to their homes if they need transportation. It is an event that brings our entire community together in the true spirit of the holidays.

We hope that you will want to support this wonderful community event. Please let me know if you need any more information.

Thank you again for your time, efforts, and consideration of our project for funding. Your donation will be put to excellent use in our community.



On behalf of the North Lake Tahoe- Truckee Leadership program, I am submitting an unusual funding request. The North Lake Tahoe-Truckee Leadership Program creates an opportunity for emerging and potential leaders to broaden their understanding of the region and its issues, challenges and opportunities. Since 2003, more than 150 individuals have successfully graduated from the program. These graduates are now using their skills to better serve their employers and our community in active community building. The future of this very valuable program is dependent upon participation and sponsorship.

We are submitting this request to the District 5 Benefit Fund in the hopes of receiving funding for one full scholarship or two partial scholarships (\$375.00 each) for applicants in need. The North Lake Tahoe-Truckee Leadership program trains emerging leaders in leadership skills; explores regional issues and broadens their understanding of the needs, challenges and resources; and provides participants with the confidence and motivation to commit to strengthening our community.

The North Lake Tahoe-Truckee Leadership Program is a collaborative project of the North Lake Tahoe Chamber of Commerce, the North Tahoe Business Association and the Truckee Donner Chamber of Commerce. New this year, the workshops will be led by Shannon Beets, the Dean of Education and Associate Provost at Sierra Nevada College in Incline Village. Each workshop is integrated with one-half of the time spent on regional issues such as special districts, planning, and non profit advocacy; and one-half on leadership skill development such as collaboration, team basics, and negotiation.

The 2010 North Lake Tahoe Truckee Leadership Program begins on January 13. The schedule consists of five sessions, and two optional days where participants will be "out in the field" getting a close-up view of issues and challenges facing our community and how various agencies work. Previous scholarship funders include the NLTRA Community Fund, the NTBA, the Leadership Alumni group, Tahoe City and Truckee Rotary and Kiwanis. We expect most of these supporters to again provide scholarships this year. All of our scholarship funders will be recognized during the program throughout the year and on the program website.





Dear Supervisor Montgomery:

I write to apply for \$1,000 from the District 5 Benefit Fund on behalf of the Dutch Flat Community Center. The funds would be used as part of the DFCC Children's Fund, to benefit families in need of financial assistance in the area served by the Community Center, from Secret Town to Emigrant Gap, along Interstate 80.

Last year, the DFCC initiated a new program as part of its Children's Fund, to provide \$100 vouchers at the Dutch Flat Trading Post in November and December for food and other items (not to include tobacco products, alcohol, or video rentals). Needy families were identified by the staff at the Alta/Dutch Flat Grammar School and their names remained confidential. The DFCC was able to provide 17 vouchers. This year, we hope to provide 20 vouchers. We already have \$705 toward our goal this year of \$2,000.

The Children's Fund supports events for children and families in the DFCC's service area, such as a spring egg hunt and a Halloween party, with a "haunted house" staffed by local volunteers and California Highway Patrol staff.

We hope the District 5 Benefit Fund Committee will grant our request to help us provide aid to families living in our area. The vouchers help both the families and the Dutch Flat Trading Post, the local grocery store which has served the area for many decades. The store is very important to local residents, especially those with limited means of transportation.

The DFCC maintains a Children's Fund, supported by donations from members and community residents. The fund is used to support activities for children and families like the DFCC's annual Halloween evening, and an egg hunt in the spring. Last year the DFCC added a holiday voucher program for local families in need of assistance, and distributed \$1,700 to 17 local families. The fund has already raised over \$500 this year in donations from local residents.

Please briefly describe how funding will be utilized by listing what items will be purchased:  
The funds will be used to buy \$100 vouchers at the Dutch Flat Trading Post in Dutch Flat. The vouchers will be given to local families in need of financial assistance, identified by the administration and staff of the Alta/Dutch Flat School. The families will remain anonymous. The vouchers may be used for food, and not for liquor, tobacco products, or video rentals.
