**Subject:** Department of Boating and Waterways Grant

**ACTION REQUESTED**

Your Board is requested to approve a budget revision and to add the equipment to the Master Fixed Asset List for the dive and boating equipment grant from the Department of Boating and Waterways in the amount of \$40,000. These funds will be utilized to purchase an integrated package consisting of a FLIR System for \$8,999; Radar System for \$24,531 and the installation costs of \$6471 for the Tahoe Marine Patrol Program. Authorization is also requested for Edward N. Bonner, Sheriff-Coroner-Marshal to execute contract documents related to the grant and for the Purchasing Manager to execute any purchasing documents related to these purchases.

**BACKGROUND**

The State Department of Boating and Waterways has awarded the Sheriff's Department a \$40,000 dive and boating equipment grant. The funds will be used for installation and purchase of a FLIR and Radar System for Marine Six, Tahoe's patrol boat. This equipment will be used to upgrade and retro fit the electronic navigation and search and rescue systems onboard Marine Six. The equipment must be purchased no later than August 1, 2010.

The Department of Boating and Waterways requires the grant contract to be approved by the Board of Supervisors as well as specific authorization for the Sheriff to execute the grant contract documents. A minute order affixed with the County's seal must be certified by the Clerk of the Board and accompany the executed contract. Failure to comply with these provisions will result in the grant contract disapproval. Your Board's approval of the budget revision and addition to the Master Fixed Asset list is also required.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The budget revision will increase the Marine Patrol Grant Program in the amount of \$40,000 for a FLIR and Radar System for Marine Six, as well as adding the offsetting grant revenue. There is no impact to the General fund.
