**BACKGROUND/COMMUNITY BENEFITS:** In approving the following contributions, the Placer County Board of Supervisors finds that each and every approved contribution serves a public purpose by promoting the general welfare of the County and its inhabitants therefore a benefit results to the County.

The Board of Supervisors is being asked to approve appropriations to help fund the Roseville High School 22<sup>nd</sup> Annual *Sober Grad Night Event* being held May 28 at John's Incredible Pizza in Roseville. 
