SUBJECT: Approve the Award of a Blanket Purchase Order as a Result of an El Dorado County Competitively Awarded Contract to Pervo Paint Company for Waterborne Traffic Line Paint for Road Maintenance in the Maximum Amount of \$160,000.00

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the award of a Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) as a result of an El Dorado County competitively awarded contract to Pervo Paint Company of Los Angeles, CA for waterborne traffic line paint for Road Maintenance in the maximum amount of \$160,000.00, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BPO.

BACKGROUND

The Department of Public Works, Road Maintenance Division (DPW), requires an annual agreement for the purchase of waterborne traffic line paint. On February 24, 2009, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors approved the award of competitive Bid No. 09-289-069 to Pervo Paint Company of Los Angeles for the purchase of waterborne traffic line paint. The resulting El Dorado County contract is effective through March 26, 2011. On March 24, 2009, your Board approved the use of the El Dorado County contract for the period April 1, 2009 through March 31, 2009. DPW has submitted a request to use the El Dorado County contract for another year. Purchasing Policy Manual Section 1.3 (e)(3) permits contracting with a vendor that was awarded an agreement by another public agency as the result of a competitive process without further competitive bidding by Placer County. The El Dorado contract offers pricing, on average, 7.4% less than pricing available from a similar State of California contract. It is very unlikely that a bid solicitation at this time would result in prices that are more advantageous than El Dorado County's contract.

FISCAL IMPACT

The BPO resulting from this recommendation will be effective for the period April 1, 2010 through March 26, 2011 in the maximum amount of \$160,000.00. DPW's Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.
