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**ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve the appointment of Supervisor Jennifer Montgomery to the Truckee Tahoe Airport Land Use Commission.

**BACKGROUND**

The Nevada County Transportation Commission is forming a new Airport Land Use Commission for the Truckee Tahoe Airport. As the Truckee Tahoe Airport is bisected by the Nevada-Placer county line, it is considered an inter-county airport. The new Airport Land Use Commission requires representation from both Placer and Nevada counties.

The Placer County Airport Land Use Commission has forwarded to Nevada County Transportation Commission a request for the Placer County Board of Supervisors and the Placer County City Selection Committee to select the "Placer County" representatives to the new Truckee Tahoe Airport Land Use Commission. The Placer County Airport Land Use Commission letter is attached for background information.

Dear Supervisor Uhler:

This letter is to inform the Placer County Board of Supervisors that the Nevada County Transportation Commission (NCTC) is working to form a new Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) for the Truckee Tahoe Airport. Because the Truckee Tahoe Airport is bisected by the Nevada-Placer county line, it is considered an intercounty airport. The new ALUC will require representation from both Placer and Nevada counties.

The Placer County Airport Land Use Commission (PCALUC) is forwarding NCTC's request for the Board of Supervisors and the City Selection Committee to select 'Placer' representatives to the new ALUC. A request has also been forwarded to public use airport managers in Placer County so they can select a 'Placer' representative with aviation expertise to the new ALUC. The March 9, 2010 PCALUC memo (attached) outlines more background.
