SUBJECT: Approve the Renewal of a Negotiated Contract with Meyers Nave Riback Silver & Wilson for Legal Services for the Redevelopment Agency in the Maximum Amount of \$185,000

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the renewal of a negotiated contract with Meyers Nave Riback Silver & Wilson of Oakland, California for Legal Services for the Redevelopment Agency in the maximum amount of \$185,000, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting contract.

BACKGROUND

On August 22, 2006 your Board approved the results of competitive Request for Qualifications (RFQ) 9569 which established a Qualified List for Legal Services for the Redevelopment Agency. As part of that same action, your Board also approved the award of an individual contract to Meyers Nave Riback Silver & Wilson, a firm competitively selected to the Qualified List, in the amount of \$75,000. Your Board subsequently approved two negotiated amendments to the contract which increased the total contract amount to \$372,000. The contract expired on June 30, 2010.

The Redevelopment Agency has requested renewal of the contract with Meyers Nave Riback Silver & Wilson for the period July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 in the maximum amount of \$185,000. Redevelopment staff has advised that they are very satisfied with the firm's performance. The firm has agreed to renew the contract for an additional year at the same terms and conditions as the previous contract. Their rate schedule will also remain the same, and has not increased since 2006.
