BACKGROUND

On May 12, 2009 your Board approved the formation of The Placer County youth Commission as an Advisory Board to the Board of Supervisors. The purpose of the Placer County Youth Commission is to integrate the youth voice into local policymaking and engage the community to create positive change. The Commission shall organize activities to help educate and motivate youth of Placer County to participate in the local political process. The appointments for approval were selected through an application and interview process by a nominating committee composed of the two adult advisors for the Commission, one adult community partner, and three former Youth Commissioners.
