SUBJECT: Placer County Youth Commission – Addition of three alternate members

ACTION REQUESTED

It is requested that your Board adopt a resolution adding three alternate members to the existing fifteen members of the Placer County Youth Commission.

BACKGROUND

On May 12, 2009 your Board approved the formation of The Placer County Youth Commission as an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors. The stated purpose of the Placer County Youth Commission is to integrate the youth voice into local policymaking and engage the community to create positive change. The Commission is also tasked with organizing activities to help educate and motivate youth of Placer County to participate in the local political process.

The Commission currently is comprised of fifteen members from the five Supervisorial Districts, District One five members; District Two four members; District Three two members; District Four one member and District Five three members. The Youth Commission is supported by staff of the University of California Cooperative Extension Program and Placer County Health and Human Services Department. Following a full year of operations, the commission is requesting that your Board approve the addition of three at-large alternate members.

Should your Board approve this request the standard student recruitment process will take place with staff returning to your Board with the requested appointments.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Funds supporting the Placer County Youth Commission are budgeted within the University of California Cooperative Extension and Health and Human Services.

Whereas, the Board of Supervisors established the Placer County Youth Commission on May 12, 2009 comprising of fifteen (15) members, by Resolution 2009-116; and

Whereas, the Placer County Youth Commission serves as an advisory body to the Board of Supervisors and other decision makers on youth related issues; and

Whereas, the Placer County Youth Commission has requested adding three alternate members; and

Whereas, the Placer County Youth Commission shall now Consist of fifteen (15) primary and three (3) at-large alternate members who shall be youth between 14 – 21 years of age, except that a youth that has not reached the age of 14 but is entering the 9th grade may be appointed; and

Whereas, The Board of Supervisors received a presentation by the Placer County Youth Commission on June 22, 2010, providing an Annual Report and an update concerning their experiences, accomplishments and impacts on the community.
