For the record, on May 13, 2010, the Native American Heritage Commission designated the Tsi-Akim Maidu tribe as the Most Likely Descendant (MLD) for the human remains that were found on May 13, 2010 on the proposed project site of the Celebration Community Fellowship Church, which is also known as the village site of Hownosum and Hownosum Ustu burial ground in Placer County. Enclosed is a Sacred Lands Inventory form to be completed and returned to our office for consideration. The form and contents are CONFIDENTIAL (California Government Code Section 6254.10 and 6254). All requests for information concerning the Sacred Lands Inventory are referred to the California Native American Consultant. The Sacred Lands form remains the property of the Tribe submitting the form and will be returned upon request. Also as the MLD, you will remain the MLD for any future finds on this site.
