SUBJECT: Approve the Renewal of Six Blanket Purchase Orders for Construction Management Services for Eastern and Western Placer County in the Maximum Aggregate Amount of \$1,350,000.00

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the renewal of six blanket purchase orders (BPOs) for construction management, construction inspection, and materials testing services for the Department of Public Works (DPW), and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BPOs in the maximum aggregate amount of \$1,350,000.00.

BACKGROUND

On April 21, 2009, your Board approved two lists of qualified firms effective through April 30, 2012 for Eastern and Western Placer County that were developed from responses to a formal Request for Qualifications process. At the same time your Board approved the award of one-year BPOs to eleven of the firms on the lists in the maximum aggregate amount of \$2,475,000.00. The Department of Public Works uses these firms for consulting services for various projects in Eastern and Western Placer County throughout the year. Public Works has requested to renew five of these BPOs for the period of September 1, 2010 through June 30, 2011 and one BPO for the period of September 1, 2010 through June 30, 2012.

The six BPOs to be renewed and their recommended expiration dates are:
