SUBJECT: Approve the Renewal of a Competitively Awarded Blanket Purchase Order with Rite Aid Corporation for Local Pharmacy Services in the Maximum Amount of \$150,000.00

ACTION REQUESTED

Approve the renewal of competitively awarded Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) No. 17216 with Rite Aid Corporation of Camp Hill, PA, for local pharmacy services in the maximum amount of \$150,000.00, and authorize the Purchasing Manager to sign the resulting BPO.

BACKGROUND

The Department of Health & Human Services' (HHS) Community Clinics, Adult Systems of Care and Children's Systems of Care require annual contracts for local pharmacy services for their clients for times when the County Clinics' pharmacies are closed or for situations where the clients are not located near the County Clinic pharmacies. On October 6, 2009, your Board approved the third BPO renewal with Rite Aid Corporation. The department of Health & Human Services has requested to renew BPO No. 17216 and Rite Aid Corporation has agreed to renew for another year at the same pricing, terms, and conditions as their original bid. Section 17 of the General Terms and Conditions of Bid No. 9606 allows the County the option to renew the contract on a year-to-year basis pending satisfactory negotiation of the renewal pricing, terms, and conditions.

FISCAL IMPACT

The department has requested a BPO in the not to exceed amount of \$150,000.00 for the period November 1, 2010 through December 31, 2011. Health and Human Services' Fiscal Impact Statement is attached.

The department has budgeted appropriately for the renewal of this \$150,000 Blanket Purchase Order (BPO) and funding for the first nine months is available in the Proposed FY2010-2011 Budget. The final three months of the BPO will be included in the FY2011-2012 Budget. The renewal amount is \$75,000 higher than the current BPO in place with Rite Aid Corporation due to a growth in caseload of mandated Medical Care Services Program (MCSP) clients. Pharmaceutical services are provided to eligible recipients as part of the mandated MCSP which is funded 100 percent by the County General Fund.
